SECOND YEAR PROFICIENCY IN SPANISH OR PORTUGUESE

As stated in the UO Catalog:

Students must satisfactorily complete, with grades of C– or better or P, two years of college-level Spanish- or Portuguese-language courses. Language credits may be earned at the University of Oregon through an approved overseas program or transferred from another accredited college or university. As an alternative, students may satisfy the language requirement by examination, demonstrating a level of competence equivalent to two years of college-level Spanish or Portuguese. Students whose native language is either Spanish or Portuguese may substitute equivalent competence in English in lieu of this requirement.

OVERALL MAJOR REQUIREMENTS

- 28 Credits Total**
- 20 Graded Credits. Courses must be completed with grades of P or C- or better**
- 20 Upper-Division (300 or 400-Level) Credits**
- 20 Credits Taken on Eugene UO campus**
- Additional Parameters (limitations and allowances) on LAS Minor Credits:**
 - **Limit on Multiple Department Credits:** No more than four departments, disciplines, or programs can count toward the minor.
 - **Limit on Single Department Credits:** No more than 12 credits from any single department can count toward the minor.
 - **Pre-20th Century Credits Required:** A minimum of 4.00 credits must be earned through completion of a course or courses whose focus is on Pre-20th Century Latin America.
 - **Allowances for non-LAS-related Credits:** 4 credits maximum can be in comparative, global, ethnic, and similar courses that are relevant to Latin American studies but lack a minimum of 50% content directly related to Latin America. (Students who seek to take a course that may fall in this category should work with a Global Connections advisor to submit a substitution request to ociasundergrad@uoregno.edu for LAS Director review and consideration.)
 - **Allowances for Study Abroad Credits:** 8 credits may be earned through successful completion of preapproved courses in study abroad program at an accredited Latin American college or university; transfer credits from universities outside Latin America are considered individually, following existing procedures in appropriate departments for determining their equivalence to UO courses.
 - **Allowances for Upper-Division Language Courses as Electives for the LAS Minor:** Spanish, Portuguese, or Indigenous language courses must be upper-division literature and culture courses to count toward satisfaction of the 28-credit minor requirement.

NOTES (regarding Overall Requirements):

Planner Guide for Advisors – select elements:

- “REQ” = “Required” – check off when course in Planner row is a “Required” course for that part of the degree requirement
- “SUB” = “Substitution” – check off when course in Planner row is an approved “Substitution” course for that part of the degree requirement
 - NOTE: If both “REQ” and “SUB” checked off, that indicates that the “Substitution” is for a “Required” course.
- “INITIAL” = column for where initials of advisors or faculty director approving the course is placed (particularly important for substitutions).
 - NOTE: “OCIAS” could be placed in this column if the course is on a term’s Course List as an approved Elective or Required course.
- “DARS” = Check off if course is showing up as needed in student’s Degree Guide. If it is not showing up as needed in student’s Degree Guide, then an email to “DARS” is required, should be sent, and then the box can be checked off.
